- Disaster Lanes on Roads for Ambulance, Fire Brigade, QRT Vehicles, PCR etc.

- vii. Perspective plan (long term) for U-EMS in the city.

Why DEMEX ???


- In mass casualty situation, saving lives and rendering critical care.
