Whereas, the Delhi Disaster Management Authority (DDMA) is satisfied that the NCT of Delhi is threatened with the spread of COVID-19 epidemic, which has already been declared as a pandemic by the World Health Organization, and has considered it necessary to take effective measures to prevent its spread in NCT of Delhi;

And whereas. Management Authority has issued Delhi Disaster orders/instructions from time to time to all authorities concerned to take all required measures to appropriately deal with the situation;

And whereas, Ministry of Home Affairs, Govt. of India vide D.O No. 40-6/2020-DM-I(A) dated 26.05.2020 (copy enclosed) has conveyed that Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Gol vide their order dated 24.05.2020, has issued guidelines for international arrivals, including for quarantine arrangements. As per these guidelines, protocol for Institutional Quarantine has been revised to 7 days followed by 7 days Home Quarantine after medical assessment:

And Whereas, it has been brought to the notice of the Ministry of Home Affairs, GoI that Indian Nationals who were quarantined in hotels after their return from abroad were made to pay advance for 14 days. Since they can now leave for home quarantine after 7 days, the amount paid by them for the remaining 7 days needs to be refunded to them, which some hotels are refusing to refund.

Now, therefore, in exercise of powers conferred under section 22 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, the undersigned, in his capacity as Chairperson, State Executive Committee, DDMA, GNCTD, hereby directs all authorities concerned to ensure that foreign returnees who were quarantined in hotels and paid advance of 14 days, shall be refunded their balance amount without any delay.
